WHAT SIN CAN TEACH YOU

One evening at a party, shortly after they met, he said something really dumb and needlessly cruel. He thought he was being clever and funny when he was really being drunk. He has never forgotten the look of hurt on her face - and it changed him profoundly. He is a more sensitive and loving husband as a result of that horrible evening.

The twelve-year old got caught shoplifting from the small grocery store at the corner. The owner refused to press charges, on the condition that she work in the store to make restitution. In the course of the afternoons she worked sweeping and restocking shelves, she saw how hard the owner worked to make a go of the little store. The youngster finished her work with a deep respect for the hard and determined work of such small-business owners.

The two couples were good friends - or so they thought. But when one couple went through a tough time, the other couple kept their distance, not wanting to get caught up in their issues. The friendship disintegrated. Then the second couple experienced a tough time themselves - and felt the loneliness and isolation they had inflicted on their one-time friends.

*Father Richard Rohr, in his book *Falling Upward: A Spirituality for the Two Halves of Life*, writes that our sins can teach us, that conversion is to learn from the wrong we do and understand that all sin has real consequences for both ourselves and others. Such is the grace experienced by those who respond to John's message of righteousness: in realizing their failings and accepting responsibility for their sins, they learned compassion, forgiveness and justice. May we possess the wisdom of God's grace to learn from the bad choices we make and transform our own sins into experiences of resurrection.*

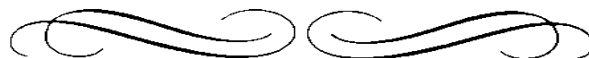
