

What is a Jubilee Year?

While in the synagogue of his hometown of Nazareth, Jesus claims the words of the prophet

Isaiah as his own: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord" (Luke 4:18-19). The "year acceptable to the Lord" he proclaims is a jubilee, which according to the Scriptures of Israel, is to occur every fiftieth year as a special time of grace in which debts are cancelled and laborers are released (Lev25:8-22).

Since 1300, the Church has celebrated jubilee years, or holy years, to commemorate occasions of significance in the history of salvation. Ordinary jubilee years occur every 25 years, though the pope can proclaim an extraordinary jubilee year, as with the Jubilee of Mercy in 2016. Every jubilee is a time of prayer, pilgrimage, and pardon.

About 100 children per year are abducted by strangers in the U.S. The reality is that most children are abducted by people they already know, a reality that is also true of almost every form of child victimization. Statistics

show that the most common way a child goes missing is by running away, or being enticed to run away by a friend or family member the child thinks is trustworthy. We can't control the dangers around them, but we can support children in learning about and developing skills to identify and establish healthy boundaries, listen to their intuition, and how to ask for help—at any age. 

COMMITTEE Our average weekly revenue for the first three months of this vear is up \$3,664.82 while our average weekly expenses are up


Three Months Ended

A "lost" family Christmas

A family gathers for Christmas.

Mom and Dad greet everyone at the door with warm hugs and help everyone with the gifts and food they brought. All the makings for a wonderful celebration are in place.

Mom lives for times like this: to have all her children and grandchildren together — but hosting Christmas is becoming more and more of a strain as she gets older, but she steadfastly refuses any offers of meaningful help. Dad does what she lets him do — but Mom is in charge. In her anxiety and exhaustion and her family's concern for her, some of the joy of this day is lost.

Mom and Dad and the other members of the family don't know that one daughter and her husband are going through a difficult time in their marriage. The couple is doing their best to keep up a good front for their children and the rest of the family — but the sadness in their faces betray what is lost.

A son was laid off from his job weeks ago. The fall has been a frustrating series of interviews that haven't paid off. Money is tight — he's embarrassed that he's hasn't been able to buy presents for everyone. The festiveness of Christmas is lost on him this year.

A grandson has just finished his first semester of college — and it didn't go well. His parents have made their disappointment clear. Where he goes from here has yet to be determined. In a house full of people, he is alone and lost this Christmas. For one granddaughter, the struggles of being a teenager cast a pall on Christmas. Her "bored" attitude masks her insecurity at this challenging time in her life. She'd rather be with her friends than be here where she feels the need to be "on." She'd rather get "lost."

And so the holiday goes for this family — and for many families at Christmas: struggling to find the "lost" Jesus.

In the struggles of maintaining relationships, meeting the demands of work and school and fulfilling the unrealistic expectations of others, we "lose" the Jesus of joy, peace and hope. Without realizing it, we wander away from the Jesus of the Gospels; we suddenly discover that the focus of our lives is not the compassion and generosity and peace of Jesus but on trying to cope with the tensions and crises of an unforgiving and judgmental world. So let this Christmas season be a time to "find" Jesus again within the love of family and friends, to "rebuild" our homes and hearts into a fitting "temple" of service and generosity for Emmanuel make his dwelling place - and, if possible, to be the means for the lost and struggling among us to "find" Jesus again in their lives.
