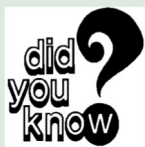

Human trafficking is happening in more places than you would think, and often it passes unnoticed because traffickers are highly skilled. If you see a situation that does not feel right, or you observe something inappropriate or concerning, you could be saving someone's life by reporting it. Often, trafficking can be noted by small indicators: someone who is deferring to another person often, or who is often controlled in who they can talk to or what they can say. Victims will also often appear to be timid or fearful, especially of a particular person, and to be isolated from other friends, family, and community members. 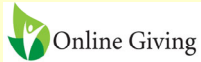

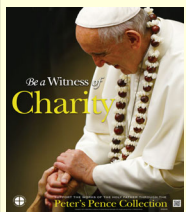

"The Nest, Empty"

It was a bittersweet moment for Valerie and his husband: the day their youngest of their four daughters left for college: though they were now officially "empty nesters," they were proud of the thoughtful, loving, intelligent and compassionate daughters they had raised.

Valerie Schultz reflects on that day in her book **A Hill of Beans: The Grace of Everyday Troubles:**

"It's been, after all, almost three decades that I've had at least one child at home. Those children have been my life's work. No matter how good a job I do at work, no matter how many published credits I accumulate, my kids will always be my chef d'oeuvre, my magnum opus. They are my joy and my bequest. They are proof of God's existence and benevolence. They are the grace of God personified . . .

"Our fledglings flown, we remain in the nest. We'll be here. We'll still be good for the occasional loan, the word of advice, laundry facilities, square meal, place to regroup, and holiday destination. The sheer physicality of parenting, the mess and immediacy of it, is over — I no longer know what every child is doing at every moment — but the spirituality of parenting endures.

"Every time one of my little birds moves out, I suffer through a small mourning period. It's nothing like death, but I grieve for a simple time that will not return. This last flight out just seems so final. I look at the stray things [my youngest daughter] has left behind — high school yearbooks, a random beanie, a half-burnt candle — and indulge in a bit of a cry. And then I blow my nose and give myself a talking-to, to be just grateful for the impossibly, deliriously blessed life God has lavished on me."

Moms and Dads know that parenthood is a full-time vocation that demands everything we have and are for the sake of the children who depend on us. Jairus, in today's Gospel, is a model of such dedicated parenthood. In his Gospel, Mark describes the father Jairus as "an official of the synagogue," a man of considerable authority in the Jewish community — an "establishment" figure, to be sure. But Jairus' love for his daughter enables him to risk his standing in the community and the reproach of his neighbors to ask this "anti-establishment" rabbi to save his daughter's life. Not only is the daughter restored to health, but Jairus and his family are transformed, as well, by the experience. Through such complete and unconditional love — like the love of God our Father for us, his children — we not only lift up the fallen but we lift up our own spirits; we not only bring healing to the suffering, we find healing for our own brokenness; we not only restore life to the dying but we restore a sense of hope and purpose to our own lives
